

Harald Stolberg Radiology Excellence Fund Application

Each applicant must provide a written reply to each of the following questions in an electronic format and emailed to the OAR office. mail@oarinfo.ca

The application should contain the following pieces of information:

Proposed International Course Information

- A description of the proposed fellowship and a description how these skills could be implemented in to an Ontario radiology setting. Is this an area where you plan to sub-specialize? What will you do with this skill when you return to Ontario? Please limit to 2 pages.
- 2. Provide information and a description of the fellowship program.
- 3. Will there be any language requirements other than English or French? If yes, do you meet the program requirements?

General Information Requirements

- 1. Provide a copy of your curriculum vitae with full contact information.
- 2. Provide a letter of reference and recommendation from the Chair of your Ontario radiology teaching program.
- 3. Provide a letter of acceptance from the international host site from the proposed site's imaging Program Teaching Head or equivalent.
- 4. Sign a letter of agreement that the applicant will ensure upon completion of the fellowship that he/she will complete a report to the OAR on behalf of the Adjudicating Committee following the completion of the educational program. This report will be in conformance with the following section (Post-Study Report Requirements).
- 5. Provide a confirmatory statement that it is the applicant's intention to practise in Ontario.
- 6. Agreement to provide receipts as required.



Post-Study Report Requirements

The report should include the following as a minimum:

- 1. Confirmation of the time and location spent on the scholarship fund with dates.
- 2. A statement from the head of the department or section with whom the applicant worked.
- Description of the learning experience in terms of what benefits the applicant gained in terms of technique and/or clinical applications, and/or scientific or research methodology. In the clinical context this statement should include a number of cases that the fellow was involved in.
- 4. A statement including the number of teaching sessions or conferences in which the applicant was involved.
- 5. Applicant should describe the Canadian context in which the learning could be applied.
- 6. Indicate if any scientific journal or meeting has/or will be created or organized arising from this experience.
- 7. All other information that the application feels adds to his/her application.
- 8. Any special considerations that should be taken into account.
